Students from the schools listed to attend on Saturday 2nd March should be at Lusk Community College at 8:45am. Students should bring:

On arrival, students will be met by a member of the LCC school community and directed to the assessment centre. It is not required that students wear their primary school uniform for the Saturday entrance assessment. Parents should be at the school entrance to collect students following the assessment, 1.00pm Saturday 2nd March. Please be very clear with your son/daughter on arrangements for collection after the assessment at 1.00pm.

Lusk NS students will complete their assessments on Friday 1st March. Students should attend LNS as normal on this day. Arrangements have been made with LNS for students to travel to Lusk Community College with their teacher and return to LNS during the normal primary school day.

Ahead of the scheduled entrance assessments, and in order to address any questions/worries that parents/students may have, information surrounding entrance assessments will be discussed at the online information event on Wednesday 28th February 2024.

IPAD Purchase – Wriggle – NO ACTION NEEDED

Lusk Community College use the Apple Ipad device as a learning tool. Students will have eBooks on their iPad and a hard copy of the book at home for homework and study.

Ipads should be purchased through our technology partner Wriggle. All Ipads in Lusk Community College are managed and configured by Wriggle. Wriggle install a management system on all devices used in the school which controls access and download of specific educational apps.

All devices in Lusk Community College must have the management system in place installed by Wriggle.

The Wriggle store will open for orders between the following dates: 2nd April – 18th June 2024 for ordering and purchasing Ipads. At a later stage, parent/guardians will be required to register and create a Wriggle Account. A store code for Lusk Community College will be sent via text to

parent/guardians in advance of the store opening date, which will allow parent/guardians to

access the LCC Wriggle Store.

Ipads orders made after the 18th June will incur a surcharge and are unlikely to be ready for the

start of the new school year. When ordered, Ipads will be delivered directly to parent/guardians

home address from Wriggle.

At this time Parent/Guardians do not need to do anything in relation to Ipads. Further information

on this will follow. The school will notify parent/guardians when action is required.

Please Note: Lusk Community College operates an E-Book Loan Scheme for all students. In the

past a fee was associated with this scheme. You may be aware of Government plans to provide

free books to Junior Cycle students. To date, we have received no information in relation to the

details of this scheme from the Department of Education. When we have information on this new

arrangement, we will inform parent/guardians.

However. it is very important that books and eBook's should not be purchased/ordered through

Wriggle.
