Dear Parent/Guardian,

I hope that this letter finds that you are well and you are enjoying the summer. As State Examinations draw to a close and in preparation for the next school year at Lusk Community College, I am writing to you to outline details concerning the return to school for the 2024/25 school year along with other relevant and important information. As the Deputy Principal with an overview of the third year group, I alongside the year head for third year students, Ms. McNamara, will work to ensure students are supported and are able to maximise their potential here in Lusk CC. Ms. McNamara will continue to be the primary point of contact for matters relating to your son/daughter in third year throughout the year.

Schedule of Return to School in August

Third year students will return on **Friday 23rd August from 9:20 – 11:20am**. All students must be present for a formal assembly in full school uniform as outlined in the schedule of return listed below.

- All third year students must arrive at 9:20am sharp on Friday 23rd August.
- All students must be in full school uniform including full black footwear.
- Students should bring their pencil case and a copy.
- Students should bring their iPads on Friday 23rd August.
- Students should bring a small snack and drink. There will be no canteen open at this point.

The School Day

- First Year, Second Year and Third Year students will start school at 8:30am every morning and attend tutor class from 8:30am – 8:38am.
- Students should arrive at school by 8:20am in order to allow time to go to their lockers.
- It is expected that students will be at their classroom at 8:30am.
- School finishes for all students at 15:35pm on Monday – Thursday and at 13:10pm on Fridays.

Academic Calendar 2024/25

Enclosed, you will find a copy of the school calendar for the 2024/25 academic year which has also been posted on the school website.

There is a strong link between attendance, student academic progress and student wellbeing. Parents/Guardians, along with the school, have legal responsibilities in relation to school attendance, student absence, and attendance reporting where a threshold of absence has been reached or where there is a concern. All school absences must be explained by the student's parent(s)/guardian(s).

Leaving the School Premises

Students who need to leave the school premises for any reason must sign out at the main office. Students who need to leave the school during the day to attend a prior appointment must produce a signed note by their parent/guardian. It is regarded as a serious breach of health and safety rules by any student to leave the school premises without prior permission and/or without having signed out at the main office.

Important Student Medical Information

A link to an online form will be sent via text in the coming week to allow parents/guardians to update/include details of medical needs of students entering third year. We would be very grateful if all parents/guardians would complete this as soon as possible. Mobile Phones

The use of mobile phones on the school grounds is prohibited. Students must switch their phones off before entering the school grounds and store safely in their school bag. We request parents/guardians' support in this matter.

Assessment reports for your son/daughter will be available to view on VShare from 24th June. Should you require any assistance, please contact the school office.

Supervised After School Study

Evening Study is highly recommended for all year groups, especially for those in Third and Sixth Year, who are preparing for State Examinations next June. It provides a quiet and structured environment for 2 hours per evening for students and creates a routine around study and the completion of homework tasks. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Further details will issue in September.

New Book Scheme Policy

Lusk Community College has operated its E-Book Loan Scheme since 2019. During this time, the school has sought to alleviate school costs for parents/guardians by providing schoolbooks, E-Books, class equipment, class resources, *etc.* at a reduced cost. From September 2024, following the introduction of the Department of Education's Free Schoolbooks Scheme for all students in Junior Cycle years, we will continue to operate the scheme, with some significant additions included, *i.e.* stationary supplies. As a result of this new scheme, the school will no longer require payment from parents/guardians for schoolbooks, e-books, class equipment/classroom resources.

- Well-maintained textbooks is central to the effectiveness of the Loan scheme.
- A single set of Exam papers per subject will be supplied to students at the start of 3rd year as part of this scheme. Exam papers do not need to be returned to the school.
- The cost of Mock Exams and corrections is not included in the scheme.
- A copy of our school's new Junior Cycle E-Book Loan Scheme is attached for your perusal.

In August 2024, in advance of students returning to school for the start of the new school year, parents/guardians will be notified when to collect books from the school. In some cases, e-book codes will be distributed when students return to school. Further details on the collection of texts and stationary as well as and accessing e-books will be made available at this time.

NB: Parents/Guardians are not required to purchase stationary, books or e-books for Junior Cycle students.

Lockers

Students will again be provided with lockers on return to school in August for the 2024-25 academic year. Students will have access to their lockers three times during the school day.

- AM: Before the school day starts
- MID: At the end of big lunch
- PM: At the end of the day

Students who wish to access their lockers in the AM should attend school at least ten minutes (8:20am) before their start time to do so.

Lusk CC uses a lock rental system in the school. The aim of this scheme is to ensure that students will no longer be required to supply their own lock for their locker, but will be supplied with a standard combination lock by the school at the start of each school year. A charge will be incurred where the supplied lock is not returned at the end of the school year.

School Canteen

Get Fresh operate our school canteen. The canteen is cashless and students must use a canteen card to purchase items. This card can be topped up online using a laptop, PC or mobile device. Third year and new students to the school can be provided with a new card in their first week back to school.



Online Payments

Please note: The school does not process online payments through the VSware App.

While the school has introduced the VSware App for parents, payments to the school are processed using the school's online payment system, MIT, which is found on our school website www.luskcommunitycollege.ie. Parents/Guardians should access the school online payment system by clicking on the icon showed by the red arrow below. The €90 Student Support Services payment, detailed below, is now set up on the MIT system. Attached is a set of instructions for making online payments. If you have difficulty accessing your MIT payment account, please contact the school office.



Student Support Services refers to payment for the following items:

- Lockers, locks and maintenance
- Student 24 hour insurance
- Text messaging
- Extra-Curricular activities
- Awards
- Wellbeing events
- Standardised testing
- VSware

Parents/guardians may contact the school in confidence to discuss payment arrangements should this be required. Please do so in the understanding that absolute discretion is assured.

VSware

VSware is the Management Information System (MIS) for Lusk CC.

There are many features for parents/guardians on VSware which in time will make communication between school and home much easier and more efficient.

For the upcoming school year, all communications from Lusk CC will be sent via VSware. It is essential that parents/guardians have their VSware account set up so they can access the following information:

- View exam/term reports
- View your son/daughters' timetables
- Monitor attendance
- Receive notifications from the school

NB: VSware can be accessed via a web browser, however, the school requests that all parents/guardians download the VSware app to your phone or to another mobile device.

Enabling push notifications to be sent from the VSware App to your device will ensure that you do not miss essential information that the school sends such as a VS Mail message, or a message to say your child is absent from school without an explanation.

We would ask that any student who is missing an item of school uniform, to please order a new uniform item for return to school in August.

We also encourage the donation of outgrown and unwanted uniform items which are always welcome and can be conveniently handed in at the school office over the summer and also throughout the academic year.

Rules relating to uniform and appearance

- The wearing of full school uniform is compulsory in school and at school related activities unless otherwise specified.
- Only the crested school jacket may be worn.
- Flared, hipster, combat, leggings, or other trousers are not uniform/PE uniform.
- Students must wear **full black footwear** to school.



PE Uniform

- All students must wear the Lusk Community College PE uniform while taking part in PE class.
- Students will continue to be allowed to wear their PE uniform to school only on the days that they are timetabled for PE.
- Lusk CC PE uniform is the ONLY acceptable PE attire.
- If students do not have a complete school PE attire, they must wear their full uniform to school and change for PE.

Jewellery

- Only one small stud earring (4mm) per ear is allowed.
- No nose, lip or other facial/body piercings are allowed.


School Office
